Use Recycled Campaign

Storage King Homebush implemented an environmental purchasing policy in 2007 which provides guidelines for purchasing products that reduce environmental impacts and increase markets for recycled products.



Use Ozone friendly fuels

We have now put in place a policy which strives to use environmentally fuels for our transport vehicles. So the next times you use our **Free Move Truck offer**, you can be sure that the fuel being used to transport your goods into storage, is less harmful for the environment.

Community Reuse

A Community Reuse Partnership program, **Storage King Homebush** strives to improve on the waste being left at the site by finding alternative uses where possible for the waste being produced. This reduces waste disposal costs and benefits the community. Such as furniture, pallets and cardboard.

Waste Reduction

Storage King Homebush believes in preventing waste before it is generated, through double-sided copies, electronic communication and reports, and recycling the paper that is being produced at the site.

Energy Reduction

We promote energy reduction in the power being consumed at the site. For example the lighting systems installed at **Storage King Homebush** only switches on during the time when a customer is present at the storage facility, once a customer leaves the premises the main lighting inside the centre is then automatically switched off. This helps us reduce the amount of power being used at the site, thereby reducing the amount of harmful materials that pollute our airspace.
